

- Received our Insurance Service Office (ISO) Class 1.
- Lieutenant Rickey Reinhardt received the Exchange Club of Beaufort's Firefighter of the Year award in 2025.



Personnel

- The department currently staffs 48 Shift Firefighters, 7 Admin Firefighters, 1 Part Time Contract Employee, and 1 Office Manager.
- The department has 9 Part-Time Firefighter positions.
- 10 firefighters became EMT certified this year, 1 became certified Advanced EMT and 4 certified Paramedic.
- Peter Dontje promoted to Deputy Chief.
- Trey Carter promoted to Battalion Chief.
- Andre Scriba and Andrew Cox promoted to Lieutenant.
- 4 firefighters promoted throughout the year to Firefighter I, II or III.

Fire Training

- The department conducted multi company live fire training and other in-house training that totaled 18,753 hours.
- Our members attended a combined 171 South Carolina Fire Academy courses with 3 graduating from recruit school.
- The Training Division conducted specialized training such as active-shooter exercises with multiple agencies, strengthening interagency coordination and response
- Members participated in statewide and national professional development opportunities, including the South Carolina State Fire Conference, South Carolina State Improvement Conference, FDIC International (Indianapolis), and the State Fire Marshal's Conference.



Community Risk Reduction

This Division continues to promote public fire and life safety education for citizens of all ages.

Trained 5,527 Children

- Installed 86 smoke alarms through partnership with American Red Cross.
- This Division now has 6 car seat technicians that performed 36 car seat safety inspections and installations.
- Social media outreach:
 - **Facebook:** Generated 11,617,121 total views in 2025 and gained 8,266 new followers, representing a 61% increase compared to 2024.
 - **Instagram:** Recorded 88,151 total views in 2025 and added 127 new followers.
- Held our 2nd annual Sparking Embers Girls Empowerment Fire Boot Camp.




Medical Division

- Medical Training
 - Educated 704 citizens on opioid awareness.
 - Conducted 996 medical in-service training hours.
 - Held 42 CPR classes certifying 332 people.



- Medical Response
 - 4,102 medical responses in 2025.
 - 1,992 (49%) of patients treated by us prior to EMS arrival.
 - Provided EKG's on 36% of cardiac patients prior to EMS arrival.
 - Attempted 124 IV's and administered medication 100 times for immediate patient improvement.





- Response totals of 6,050 calls for service in 2025.


